**Levels:** Training through Grand Prix. AA and Jr/YR classes offered as noted if entries warrant. 2009 GAIG/USDF and BLM Qualifying classes offered.

**Awards:**

- Trophy and six ribbons in each class. Trophy will be awarded only in classes with 3 or more entrants for each non-championship class.
- Eight Ribbons and First place prizes for each GAIG/USDF Championship class. Prize money for Great American/USDF Regional Championships will be paid directly by the USDF office to the recorded horse owner within 30 days of the last day of each championship. Prize money will be \$314 to the Champion and \$210 to the Reserve Champion for each championship. Riders placing in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship classes must be present, mounted and in full riding attire for award ceremonies. (Competitors may decline to participate in the victory round.) Failure, without prior permission of the competition manager, to be present and properly attired will eliminate the official score and placing and the next highest score will move up in placing. The tentative schedule for the awards ceremonies will be printed in the Show Program and the confirmed schedule will be posted in the show secretary's office by noon on the day prior to the start of the competition.-
- ESDCTA Perpetual Dressage Trophies will be awarded at this show. Competitors should check the secretary's office to sign up for the perpetual trophies and any other special sponsored awards.
- USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal will be awarded on Second Level Test 3 on Saturday.
- USEF Dressage Seat Medal Semi-Finals: Ribbons to 6th place, medals and special awards to Champion and Reserve.

All entries MUST submit USEF and USDF documents for rider, owner, trainer and horse as appropriate for entry, non-refundable \$20 office fee, a negative Coggins dated within 12 months of show, and payment. If not stabling, haul-in fee must be paid per horse per day. Please include USEF non-member fee, \$5 discipline fee or any other membership/horse registration fee(s) if applicable. All entry forms must have three signatures including emergency info. Make checks payable to **ESDCTA, Inc.** Do not send entries registered or signature required, as you will receive entry confirmation via email or by including SASE. Refunds will be given for cancellations received in writing, email, or fax before the closing date less \$20 office fee. **No refunds after closing date or for 'acts of god' which require management to cancel classes or day(s) of competition.** Non-negotiable check will be charged \$25. Entries received after the closing date will be accepted if space available with a \$50 post entry fee. Non-competing horses if space available, \$45 plus office fee. Competitors who are a no show for one class will be considered to have scratched for the duration of the show.

**Times:** Times and stall assignments will be on the websites, [www.esdcta.org](http://www.esdcta.org) and [www.centerlineevents.com](http://www.centerlineevents.com), at least one week prior to the competition. If you wish for your times to be sent, please include SASE.

**Stabling:** 276 permanent stalls with full doors (board on bottom and chain link fencing on top). No initial bedding provided. Use of straw bedding will incur a \$20/stall additional fee by the Horse Park unless competitor cleans stall. Arrival time is no earlier than 12:00 noon on Oct 9th. If you need stabling before this time please contact show secretary to make arrangements for early arrival. No refunds on stabling after closing.

**Directions:**

**From NJ Turnpike and I-195East** - Take Exit 7A to Route 195 East to Exit 11. Make a left to Route 524, then make a right. Horse Park is on the left, approximately 1 1/2 miles.

**From the Garden State Parkway** - Take Exit 98 to Route 195 West to Exit 11. Make a right to Route 524, then make a right. Horse Park is on the left, approximately 1 1/2 miles.

**From Rt 537W (Freehold, NJ)** – Rt 537W to Rt 524, Horse Park will be on right, (15 mins from center of Freehold).

**Footing:** Four stone dust arenas with stone dust warm up. If Indoor is used, footing is dirt. Lunging only in designated area. Competition arenas are 20m x 60m or 20m x 40m.

**Entertainment:** Food available on the grounds beginning 7am each day. Competitor's Lunch on Saturday. Guest may attend the luncheon for \$10/ticket.
